

Strengthening involvement / Recruiting Safety Reps/Activists

PURPOSE:

- * to involve members/recruit safety reps/strengthen H&S organisation
- * To develop ‘organising meeting’ skills

WHAT TO DO:

In small groups,

- 1) decide on a workplace and the key issues that you wish to focus on in recruiting new safety reps.
- 2) Plan and prepare a short (5 min?) speech aiming to motivate members and/or recruit new safety reps.
- 3) Choose someone to deliver the speech to the rest of us at a lunchtime meeting.
Then decide on the structure/agenda/timing for the meeting.....
Then decide on other key roles in the team; a chairperson, backup speaker(s), a ‘mover’ of any motion you feel appropriate etc
- 4) Conduct your meeting in an efficient, focussed manner, encourage contributions and bring it to a successful conclusion (a vote on a motion/ a call for volunteers for new reps?)
