HAZARDS CAMPAIGN Sponsorship of Hazards Conference 2023 to be held 1st - 3rd September at Keele University

In 2022, we held our first in-person Hazards Conference since 2019. The conference was held at Keele University and online for those unable to attend in person or who wanted to be online. It created a few challenges but overall provided a great conference experience for all attendees.

We purposely organised for the conference to be smaller than in previous years, to enable us to ensure people were able keep their distance around the venue and that ventilation was maintained at a safer level.

And we organised the agenda to enable people who joined online to participate fully in debates, as much as possible. Around 150 reps and activists attended in person and more than 30 attended online.
